3. Why is the last half of the seven year Tribulation referred to as the "great Tribulation"?
4. How is the return of Christ described in 24:23-31 different from the return at the Rapture described in 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18? (See also 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12).
5. In Matthew 25, who do the ten virgins represent?
6. In regards to Matthew 25:1-13, fill in the blank:
The bridegroom (v. 1, 5, 10) represents _____.
The wedding (v. 10) represents _____.
The oil in the lamps (v. 3-4) represents _____.
The bride (not stated in this parable nor in the parable of the Wedding Feast in Matt 22) represents _____.
Provide one passage in Revelation which helps us understand the identity of the bride _____.
7. Since Matthew was written to Jews and since Jesus was addressing Jews, most dispensationalists interpret Jesus' parables as if only the Jews will be involved in their fulfillment. What other category of people might the parable of the virgins (25:1-13) and the parable of the talents (25:14-30) apply? (Clue: the answer is not the Church).
8. What do the "talents" represent in the parable of the talents (25:14-30) and to which dispensation does the parable apply?
9. Why was the third servant excluded from the kingdom in the parable of the talents (25:14-30)?
10. To whom was Jesus referring when He mentioned "the least of these my brethren" in 25:40?
